JPII Update #1: Coronavirus

Dear JPII Community Members,

Our administrative team has established a plan to address the coronavirus should it become a factor in our community. While cautiously optimistic, we have developed this plan based on the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Washington State Department of Health (WSDOH).

PLEASE KNOW:

- **Students, teachers, staff, and volunteers who are sick or have a fever of 100 degrees or greater should not come to school.** If you are running a fever, you should remain home until at least 24 hours after the fever is completely gone. Running a fever is just one of the symptoms of illness (see additional info below).
- If a student at school is running a fever of 100 degrees or above, their parent(s) will be notified and expected to pick them up immediately.
- If one person is confirmed to have coronavirus in our school, we will close the building for cleaning and disinfection.
- The administration is in the process of more detailed planning in case our school needs to close for extended periods. We are fortunate to have the use of advanced technology for curriculum delivery and are investigating multiple solutions for distance learning. More information will follow as necessary.

We all have a role to play in keeping our entire community safe and healthy. We thank you all for taking that role seriously.
