For the health and safety of our community, Pope John Paul II High School has partnered with Key Bridge Medical Clinic (Dr. Kerbie Barrantes, DNP-FNPC) to provide COVID Testing on-site at our school. The testing procedure will maintain proper precautionary measures and follow CDC guidelines. The Rapid Antigen (15-minute result) and PCR tests will be administered at no cost to the school or the students, as they are covered by HRSA, an agency of the US Department of Health. COVID tests will be offered and administered to students who wish to attend the Homecoming Dance, to athletes who need to test in order to participate in sports and to other students and staff who show symptoms and/or request a test. The clinic will be present on a weekly basis, starting Oct. 20, 2021. By signing the consent form below, you are allowing the clinic staff to administer the test to your child upon request without a parent present.
